

LOTL BOTL

The Army may include Lotl-Botl as a Lizardman Special Character. He is a Saurus Hero.

Old, savage veterans among the Saurus warriors tend to become the leaders of Saurus legions of the temple cities. One of the most notable of these heroes is Lotl-Botl, whose name roughly translates as “Very Hard.”

Lotl-Bol and his Saurus legion guard the ancient and most revered Mage-Priests of Xlanhuapec and the sacred temples of this city. Lotl-Botl is no great intellect and his tactical skills are negligible, but such things are not really required from a Saurus commander. Lotl-Botl has the great Saurus virtues of determination, savage ferocity, stubbornness, unquestioning loyalty and malicious spite for all enemies of the Lizardmen, both known and unknown. He is truly great among Saurus.

Weapons/Armor: Lotl-Botl is armed with a hand weapon, light armor and shield.

Save: 3+ (2+ for hand weapon & shield bonus in Close Combat).

SPECIAL RULES



Cold Blooded. Lotl-Botl does not carry magical items. Instead he has natural abilities that cannot be nullified by weapons or attacks that affect magical items.

Blood-Curdling Roar

Lotl-Botl’s blood-curdling roar is exceptionally savage and frightening even for a Saurus. Lotl-Botl therefore *Causes Fear*.

Cold-Blooded Determination

Lotl-Botl does not like giving ground in hand-to-hand combat. If the enemy are coming at him from all sides and trying to overwhelm him, it just makes him angrier. He wades into the pressing throng cutting a swath right into the heart of the enemy unit yelling to his warriors to follow him. Any unit of Saurus accompanied by Lotl-Botl will be inspired by his presence, becoming harder to beat in close combat and will gain a +1 bonus to their combat result.

Rationalization:

4th Edition Army Book had him rated as 18 points above the cost of a basic Saurus Hero. Therefore, Lotl-Botl is a basic 7th Edition Saurus Hero with 20 points added to his points cost (18 pts. rounded up).
